

ACTIVE DUTY WITH 180 DAYS OR LESS.

A US Department of Veteran Affairs Benefits Delivery before Discharge (BDD) claim is for active duty who have 180 to 90 days left of service. The purpose of the program is to help service members complete their service-connected disability claim process prior to their last day of service so the veteran can receive compensation they are eligible for as quickly as possible.

If you have less than 90 days left, don't worry about it. You should also start the process now.

Please answer the following questions:

- 1) Full name and phone number
- 2) Branch of service
- 3) Month/Day/Year entered active duty
- 4) Projected date of separation
- 5) Terminal leave? Start date?
- 6) Anticipated type/condition of discharge
- 7) Will you be leaving the area upon separation/terminal leave?
- 8) City or county of your current residence.
